Terms & Conditions for Material Submitters and Competitors

Material Submitter Non-Competition

- 1. Individuals and teams can submit materials, videos or posters without necessary choosing to participate in the Competition.
- 2. There is no limit to the number of submissions for those submitting video clips and posters but do not want to be considered for a prizes

Submission for Competition to be considered for a Prize

- 3. Individuals and teams can also submit videos or posters to be entered into a competition for a prizes
- 4. The SAIP staff and engaged student-volunteers are not allowed to enter the Competition.
- 5. Competitors can enter the Competition as individuals or in a team.
- 6. The Competition is in two categories, video clips and posters. Individuals/teams can only have one competition entry per category. That is a maximum of only one poster to be considered for Competition and a maximum of only one video to be considered for Competition.
- 7. Individuals or teams can choose to enter the Competition at five levels which are, school learner, undergraduate, postgraduate, researcher/academic or general public

Conditions applicable to both submitters and competitors

- Material submitters/ competitors give consent to SAIP to include and edit their submissions for the combined documentary on **Physics in my Village**, and the SAIP will, in turn, give full credit to content creators whose materials will be selected for use.
- 10. Materials submitters/competitors may be approached for further interviews and involvement with the project and documentary filming and production
- 11. No late submission will be allowed. The closing date is 25 June 2021.
