The Physics Department is a dynamic and growing department within the Faculty of Science at UCT. We seek to fill a permanent academic position at the rank of either Lecturer or Senior Lecturer (on academic teacher conditions of service). The main requirement of the position is to convene and lecture to large first year classes, supervise large tutorial groups, and to provide academic and managerial leadership to the first year physics teaching laboratory. There is no requirement to undertake research, although engagement in the scholarship in teaching and learning is expected, and research in Physics Education would not be discouraged.

Requirements:

- An MSc in Physics or Physics Education, or equivalent;
- At least 3 years' experience in lecturing at a tertiary level to large classes;
- A lecturing track record that demonstrates experience, recognition, innovation and creativity;
- A willingness to lecture at least a double lecture load to large classes; and
- A willingness to contribute to inter-faculty and departmental-level administration.

Selection and placement at lecturer or senior lecturer level will be informed by evidence of:

- Experience in teaching and convening very large classes over a sustained period;
- Contributions to curriculum development; and
- Experience in managing large teaching laboratory and/or tutorial programmes.
